HOSPITALS

EVELETH FITZGERALD COMMUNITY HOSPITAL: A 50-bed hospital opened in 1959, financed through the efforts of its citizens; has 40 doctors, 28 of whom are specialists; equipment up to date in all departments; can perform any service in the hospital; qualified help in every department. The hospital received the "Outstanding Award for the Most Modern Hospital" in June, 1960.

ARROWHEAD NURSING HOME: 82 beds; 39 paid employees; 10 Grey Ladies; 10 volunteers. A new addition to the hospital was opened January 15, 1962, with 32 beds (included in the 82-bed total).

INDUSTRY

The Recreational Building was the first of its kind on the Mesaba Range. After being remodeled, this building is now occupied by Cluett, Peabody Co., a shirt and shorts factory, employing 172 persons. This factory has been in operation for sixteen years.

Kangas-Jacobson Dairy: Employs 25 persons.

LEGISLATION

According to a law passed by the State Legislature, a commission was established to select a site for a school and hospital for retarded children. The law states that such an institution should be located in the Iron Range Area of the State. The citizens of Eveleth have been working diligently on this project, offering the golf course site for this hospital.

A committee headed by the Superintendent of Schools, Robert Brown, is working with the proper authorities to establish an area vocational school in Eveleth.

BUILDINGS

Eveleth has more than 125 business establishments. Among the City's outstanding public buildings are the City Hall and the Public Library, one of the most modern and complete in the Arrowhead, with more than 22,500 volumes.

The Hippodrome, recently remodeled at a cost of approximately \$160,000, is probably the only one of its kind in Minnesota. This building is used as a hockey arena, having an artificial ice plant. The main sheet of ice measures 190 ft. x 85 ft. and has a seating capacity of 3,000. It is also used for basketball tournaments.

The Curling Club has four sheets of ice, an artificial ice plant, and has a membership of 300.

Eveleth has its own airport, radio station (WEVE), a weekly newspaper and a bus depot serviced by two bus lines, Greyhound and Northern Transportation.

The City owns and operates its own water distribution system and filtration plant.
